Courtney is our child safety officer and along with several of our senior teachers and as a collective team we ensure that your child's dance journey is a safe, happy, and memorable one. We only employ the most highly trained and qualified staff to keep our students safe. We support our staff to continue expanding their knowledge and ensure that professional development is undertaken. We have a strict risk assessment and management strategy as well as policies surrounding record keeping, information sharing and external reporting.

All of our policies and procedures have been influenced by our students and these are available on our website or in our office area at i-Dance. When creating these policies and procedures we have made it a priority to ensure that diversity has been respected. Courtney is contactable anytime for students, parents, staff, or volunteers to discuss concern.
